



Entries are open for the 2020 Orange Running Festival and we would like to invite your School to enter a team in the **McDonald's 5km Schools Challenge** being held on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

The Orange Running Festival is an annual event co-ordinated to promote health and fitness and raise money to donate to local charities.

The **McDonald's 5km Schools Challenge** is a great opportunity for team building, community involvement and encouraging physical activity.

The registration process for 2020 has been streamlined making it even easier for your School to enter.

Information about the **McDonald's 5km Schools Challenge**:

- Your school may enter a team in the Primary or Secondary division (or both if K-12 school).
  - Any staff teams should be entered in the Business Challenge. (Please see our website for more information)
  - Teams require a minimum of five (5) students and maximum of fifteen (15). If there are more than 15 students, multiple teams are to be entered to include 5 to 15 students in each team.
  - Teams competing in the **McDonald's 5km Schools Challenge** run (or walk) must register in the Hotel Canobolas 5km event and then choosing the Team option for the Schools Challenge.
  - The start and finish are located at the Gosling Creek Reserve, Bloomfield Road, Orange.
  - Start time is 10.30am and students are asked to meet with their appointed teacher at 9.45am.
  - Bib collection is preferred on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> March between 10:30am – 3:00pm from the Gosling Creek Reserve or from 6:30am on race day.
  - Entry Fees:
    - (13 and over) \$15.00\*
    - (Under 13) \$10.00\*
- \*Entry fees will remain the same after early bird closes*
